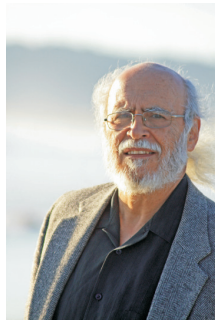

Native Californian Joe Garcia is an established landscape and wildlife artist living and painting near the small mountain town of Julian, California. The natural setting

amidst oaks and pines, and the golden hills of Southern California provide endless inspiration and subjects for his art.

Encouraged by friends and family to pursue an artistic career, Joe earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree with an advertising/illustration emphasis from the Art Center College of Design in Los Angeles. He worked as an illustrator and graphic designer for 13 years, then left the

These same artists often receive fees of hundreds of dollars for the same kind of workshops they provide here; yet FAA members can benefit from their expertise for only \$30! Joe was chosen to judge the 2010 Federal Duck Stamp Contest in October 2010 in Berkeley, California. He was honored to be involved in the selection process of this esteemed award. The panel of five gave the honor to James Hautman, a respected member of the wildlife art community and winner of the contest three times previously.

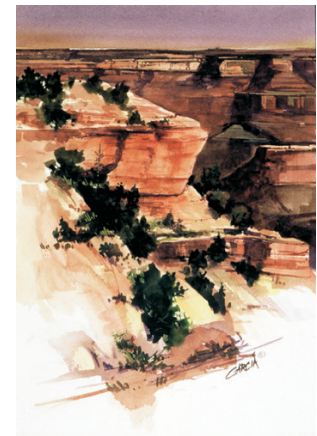

BRANDON GALLERY FEATURES FALLBROOK ART ASSOCIATION'S

BILL RIEDELL IN MAY

Bill Riedell, noted North San Diego County artist and frequent award winner in regional juried art exhibitions, will display selected pieces of his art at Fallbrook's Brandon Gallery May 3-31, 2011.

Riedell's large volume of work consists of near-photographic watercolors and pastels that revere landscapes and seascapes in the western United States. The past president of the Fallbrook Art Association (FAA) has won numerous awards at FAA shows as well as the respected Del Mar Fair.

A public reception will take place at the gallery Saturday, May 7, 2011, from 3 - 5PM.

Riedell joined FAA in 1993 when he returned to southern California after a distinguished career as an illustrator and commercial artist in New York City. Trained at the Los Angeles Art Center, he refined his style at workshops conducted by leaders in watercolors and pastels, including Dan Burt, Brad Fragers, George James, Carole Katchen and Sally Strand, all of whom helped develop Riedell's approach to painting realistic images of nature and people and their architecture.

SPECIFICATIONS:

- All work must be dry and, if framed, be properly secured within the frame
 - With screw eyes and wire. **Wire ends must be wrapped with tape to prevent injury to hanging crew.**
 - **NO** saw-tooth hangers
- Diptychs and triptychs will be considered one work
- Artist's name, phone number, title of work and asking price must be on the back of each entry
- Placement and removal of any 3-dimensional piece exceeding 50 lbs. is artist's responsibility
- No size limits on 3-dimensional stand alone pieces, but must be of reasonable size for handling. Show chairperson will make final determination.
- Paintings, photos, graphics, computer works and mixed media may be covered with glass if the size is 30"x30" or less (excluding frame)
 - Plexiglas is required on larger pieces – except on pastels and charcoal works
- Gallery wrap ends must be finished
- Maximum size allowed is 48" w x 60" h, including frame
- Diptych/Triptych maximum is 48" w x 60" h for all pieces, including frames
- All work must be suitable for general viewing
