UPCOMING PROGRAMS

In September, we'll be welcoming back **Ken Goldman** with a completely new program entitled: “TRANSFORMING THE REPRESENTATIONAL INTO A LYRICAL DESIGN”

This will be an exciting opportunity to see into his unusual and fascinating life journey that has led him to become the artist he is today. At the end, Ken will show a 2-minute time-lapse portrait demonstration of how he approaches a watercolor portrait. His workshop the following Sunday is entitled: “Art Analyzation & Revitalization”. Ken will get beginning artists started with time-tested drawing basics and help intermediate artists find their next level. Critiques, advice, demonstrations and instruction are all individual so no one need feel under-qualified.

Karen Levi will be demonstrating new pastel techniques at our **October** meeting and her workshop will focus on how to create good compositions when using photos as the source of a painting.

In **November**, we will be featuring **Mike Gulewich**, who paints 250-270 exquisite oil landscapes every year! He will show us how he accomplishes such a prolific creative outpouring.

December will once again be the time for us to get together for a **potluck** to celebrate all the various holidays that occur in December.

In **January**, **Mike Miller** will not only demonstrate his fine art techniques with acrylic paint, but he has promised to give each of the attendees a gift of a book that he has published.
