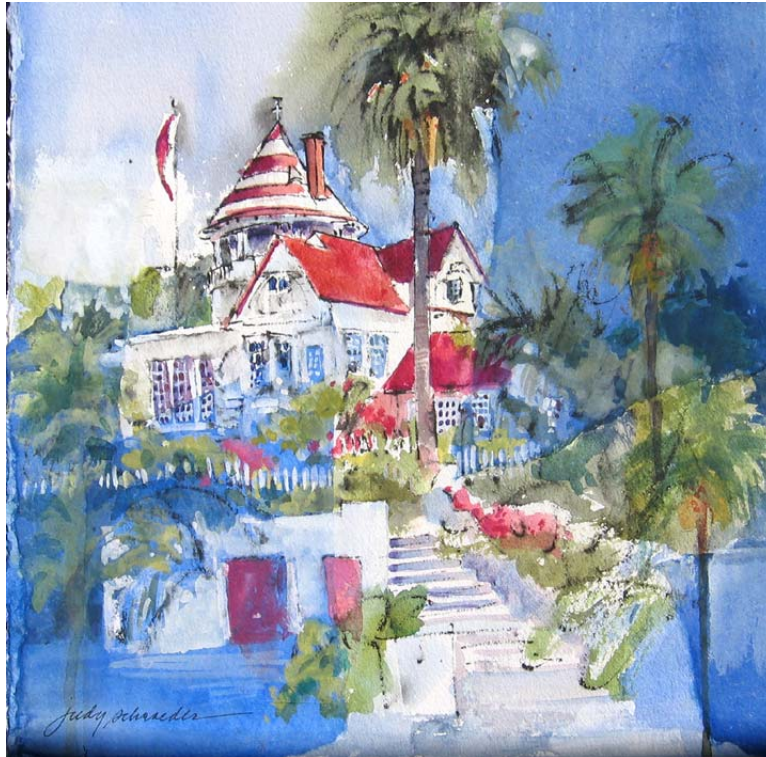

SPECIFICATIONS:

All work must be dry, framed securely, have screw eyes and wire attached, and be ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers.

Name of artist, title of work and phone number on back of each entry. Maximum length on any one side including frame shall be 54 inches. Diptychs and triptychs will be considered as one work. Three-dimensional work more than 50

pounds, artist responsible for placement and removal. No size limits on three-dimensional stand alone, but must be of reasonable size, Show Chairpersons will make final determination. Paintings, photos, graphics, computer works and mixed media may be covered with glass if the size is 24"x24" or less excluding frame. Plexiglas is required on larger pieces, pastels and charcoal works exempted. Gallery wrap ends finished. **ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLE FOR GENERAL VIEWING.**

COMMISSIONS:

A 25% commission on ALL sales resulting from this show shall be paid to the FAA.

LIABILITY:

The Fallbrook Art Association, its Officers, Directors, agents or representatives, assume NO responsibility for damages, theft or loss to entries in this show. All entries being received are subject to these conditions. Insurance is the responsibility of each artist.
