MAY MEETING AND DEMO

Jon Harwood

Jon Harwood studied photography at Santa Ana College and California State University Fullerton. During the last three years he has returned to active photographic work. He works with traditional black and white photographic process in his fine art oriented work. Subjects come from the natural and urban landscape in the Fallbrook area and often feature the interaction of the land, people and agriculture. Nineteenth century photographers and processes as well as modern monochrome photographers influence him. Jon teaches classes in basic and intermediate digital photography at the Art Campus of Fallbrook.

Now that shows are accepting digital photographs in the place of the traditional slide, it is necessary for artists at all levels to be able to submit work in a digital form. Luckily, the equipment needed to produce acceptable photographs is not extremely expensive. The techniques of making photographs with computers can be learned with a modest effort.

Jon will be giving a presentation on May 14th, on "Going Digital". You will explore methods of creating a good quality digital photograph with simple equipment. While there is nothing wrong with fine digital equipment, Jon will demonstrate how to produce good quality pictures with low-end digital cameras, common computers and simple shooting setups.

What you will do is look at just the essential things one needs to know to make a good picture. When the essentials are pointed out, it becomes much easier to deal with digital photography and it becomes possible to have a good time instead of getting frustrated. After the presentation Jon hopes that you will be able to begin enjoying your digital cameras and using them to photograph your own artwork.

Jon is looking forward to seeing you at the "Going Digital" presentation.

There will be no "Eat 'n Critique" at this Demo.
