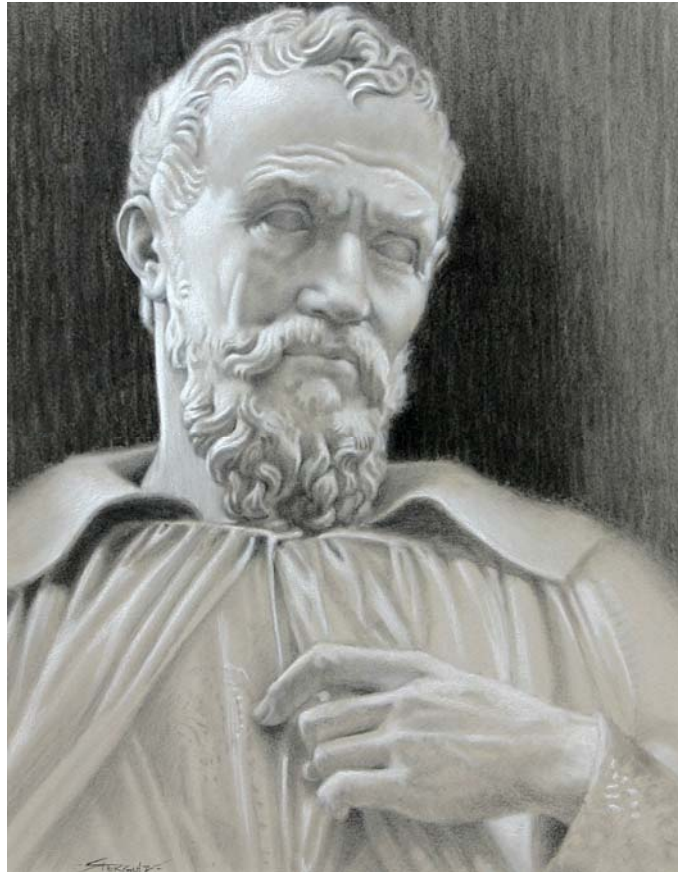

Rich Stergulz

The Fallbrook Art Association's next general meeting will feature Richard Stergulz who works in oils on masonite board and plein air painting Monday November 13th, at 7:00 pm at the Hilltop Center, 331 E. Elder in Fallbrook. In addition to demonstrating at the meeting Rich's demo will focus on painting the portrait and showing how to block in the face using big shapes to small shapes. Getting to know the planes of the face along with the value and temperature relationships. He will go over a couple of flesh color mixtures. Rich will hold a workshop on Saturday November 18th, from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm School of The Arts, 310 E Alvarado, Fallbrook. Richard is an Illinois native who by the age of eight knew he wanted to be an artist. He graduated from the American Academy of Art in Chicago in 1983 which began his successful commercial art career. After 12 years of doing commercial art, Richard felt it was time to fine tune his fine art style. Richard moved to California in 1995 and started painting for himself in a realistic style with a touch of Russian impressionism. "I admire the Russian Impressionists, especially Nickolai Fechin, for their intense brush strokes that exude passion into their paintings. I also admire Norman Rockwell for his amazing drawing ability and the volume of work he produced in his lifetime." Lastly, Richard admires John Singer Sargent for his portrait work. "His portraits give a sense of reality but still have a painterly style which I hope to aspire to."

Richard works in oils on masonite board. His work is mostly figurative and he has started plein air painting as much as possible. He also teaches class three times a week as well as doing demos for most of the Art Associations in San Diego and Riverside counties. Richard's work hangs in galleries in Folsom, Idyllwild and Fallbrook, California. His paintings have won numerous awards from Best of Show to People's Choice.

Preceding the meeting there will be an informal "Eat 'n Critique" session from 5:30 until 6:30 pm. Participants in the critique are encouraged to bring one or two "painting in progress" plus a snack or box dinner to eat during the session. Refreshments will be served following the meeting. John Villani, the author of "100 Best Art Towns In America" was invited by the Fallbrook Village Association to visit our "Friendly Village" and tell us what we needed to do to be included in his next book. During his recent visit he was shown Fallbrook's unique art facilities and businesses. He met with the many groups, community leaders, business owners and individuals who are intent on making Fallbrook an art destination. We told him the good and the not-so-good things about our town. At a meeting attended by dozens of interested parties, Mr. Villani spoke about his findings. He then surprised everyone by announcing that Fallbrook will be listed in his next book! The other California art towns already listed are: Laguna Beach, Idyllwild, Palm Springs, Mendicino, Carmel, Chico, Eureka and LaJolla.

There are a lot of committees, boards, individuals, businesses and organizations in Fallbrook who are working to follow a tourism study which advised us to take advantage of the unique facilities our small town has to offer, and other towns envy. Facilities like the Art Center, the Art Campus and our historic downtown galleries which are all within walking distance of each other. All of this can make Fallbrook a tourist destination, a place to come to for art and art-related interests. The new "art of" festivals were an early result of this movement as well as many other community actions, such as the formation of committees and groups working on art in public places, signage, way-finding and welcoming gateways. A new visitors bureau has been formed and there is a new collaboration amongst all the artistic groups including music, theatre, film making and, of course, the Art Association.

Fallbrook is looking to the Art Association and its members to be a part of this exciting movement. So, the next time the sign-up sheet is passed for participation in the festivals, art shows, plein air opportunities and competitions, be sure your name is on the list both as a participant and as a volunteer.

Artists whose work has been in this exhibit since July 1, 2006 should plan on picking up that artwork at this time and if they want to enter new work, they may do so during this time period, or artists may bring in new work at this time if unable to do so later. **(All artwork hanging in the gallery since July 1, 2006 must be removed no later than 3:00pm.)**

11:30am - 1:00pm **Building closed/locked for lunch break**

1:00pm - 3:00pm Artists may continue to bring in new work for display and/or pick up artwork on display since July 1, 2006 **(No artwork will be accepted after 3:00PM)**

THEME

We will have no particular theme for this showing, just good fine art only from FAA Members. However, anything depicting "Performing Arts" is particularly welcome in the exhibit. **This Is Not A Juried Event.** Limit two (2) pieces per member. All work submitted for exhibit must be suitable for general viewing. Paintings must be dry, framed, ready to hang with wire attached. No sawtooth hangers. Artist name, phone number and title on back of each piece (required).

Cost for the six month period is \$5.00 for each piece of art, cash or a check made payable to the "Fallbrook Art Association", on delivery of your artwork for exhibit. A 10% commission is payable by the artist, to the "Bob Burton Center for the Performing Arts", for any artwork sold during the showing. The artist, not the FAA is responsible for

any sales tax on items involved in any transaction in this event. We expect to change again in July 2007. Mark your calendar for this important opportunity to exhibit your artwork.
