Karen Levi Demo

- Nov. 14th

This presentation will focus on the unique qualities of the pastel medium.

Karen began her painting career as an oil painter, but several years ago she picked up pastels and has never looked back. She loves the brilliance and the immediacy of the pastel medium and enjoys the fact that working with pastels is ‘part drawing and part painting.’ She embraces the versatility of the medium and frequently experiments with mixed media techniques.

Karen’s varied and distinguished background includes earning a BFA in painting and drawing from the Dayton Art Institute. After graduation she embarked upon a career as a commercial artist, which included several years as an illustrator for NASA. She then began to pursue her passion for working in the pastel medium by continuing her studies at the Art Students League of New York, and with such notables as Ben Konis, Harley Brown, Daniel Greene and Sally Strand.

Karen makes her home in Murrieta, California. Prior to that she lived in Redlands, California, where she was appointed to the advisory panel for the Redlands Arts Commission. She is the recipient of numerous awards including Best of Show at the Fine Arts Institute juried show at the San Bernardino

County Museum, and First Place in Plein Air painting at the Fallbrook Art Association Open Show.

Her work is in corporate and private collections throughout the United States. Professional associations include Pastel Society of San Diego, Pastel Society of the West Coast and the Woman Artists of the West. She is a popular speaker and workshop instructor. November 19th Pastel Workshop

Given by Karen Levi

You will do exercises to familiarize yourselves with the medium, and then take what you've learned and apply that to a finished composition. Be prepared to work hard and have lots of fun.

The materials for the class include 'soft' pastels. The larger the set(s) that you use, the more variety you will have in colors and values. I suggest that you bring all that you have.

If you plan to buy pastels, I would suggest buying a minimum 60 half stick set of Rembrandts, and a small set of NuPastels, both available from Aaron Brothers/Michaels. Another really good alternative to Rembrandt is 'Holbein' (available in ASW regular catalog), an excellent brand from Japan. Art Supply Warehouse has a Goldfaber 72 Half Stick set for \$21.99. They are 'student grade.' Might be worth trying if you are new to pastels. There are many other brands that you can buy in varying degrees of softness. If you have any questions, feel free to call me at 951-696-8201.

You can get a catalogue from ASW by calling 1-800-995-6778 or www.aswexpress.com.

Ask for sale catalog 30M as well as their regular catalog. They have a good variety at competitive prices. Be sure to allow 10 days for shipping.

We will be using Canson paper. It is available in many colors and values and can be purchased anywhere art supplies are sold. It lists for \$1.98 for a 19"x 23" sheet. I buy Canson paper in bulk, and will bring an assortment to class for you to purchase if you need it.

Other materials that we will use are:

- **Vine or willow charcoal**
- **Compressed charcoal**
- **Paper towels (I prefer Viva)**
- **A drawing board, and clips to attach your paper.**
- **Masking tape**
- **Easel**
- **Aluminum foil for a tray under your drawing board to catch dust**

Note: Please bring table and floor covering to protect carpet and tables at the FPUD.

BOB BURTON PERFORMING ARTS CENTER CHANGE OF LOBBY ART GALLERY EXHIBIT

To all FAA members, we will be changing the art exhibit at the Bob Burton Center for Performing Arts lobby (at Fallbrook High School). Fallbrook High School is located at 2400 S. Stagecoach Lane, cross street South Mission. The Performing Arts Center theater is located just east of the school buildings near the baseball field.

THIS WILL BE ONE DAY ONLY!

The schedule of events is planned as follows:
9:30AM – 11:30AM Artists whose work has been in this display since June 2005 should plan on picking up that artwork at this time and if they want to enter new work, they may do so during this time period as well. Or any artist may bring in new work if unable to do so later.

11:30AM – 1:00PM Building closed/locked for lunch break.

1:00PM – 3:30PM All artists who wish to enter new artwork in this display and are not picking up, may bring it in during this time period.

Anyone who is unable to make the above times, we will be open on that day until approximately 4:00PM at the very latest, placing and hanging the new art work.

WE EXPECT ALL ARTWORK, which has been in the gallery since June to be taken out by the artists no later than 3:30PM.

THEME – Again we will have no particular theme for this showing, just good fine art from our members. However, anything depicting “Performing Arts” is particularly welcome in the exhibit.

THIS IS NOT A JURIED EVENT. All work must be suitable for general viewing. Limit of two (2) pieces of artwork per artist. Paintings must be dry, framed, ready to hang with wire attached.

No sawtooth hangers. Artist name, phone number and title on back of each piece. Cost for the six month period will remain at \$5.00 for each piece, cash or a check made payable to the FAA, on delivery of your artwork for exhibit.

A 10% commission is payable by the artist, to the “Bob Burton Center for the Performing Arts”, for any artwork sold during the showing. The artist, not the FAA is responsible for any sales tax on items involved in any transaction in this event.

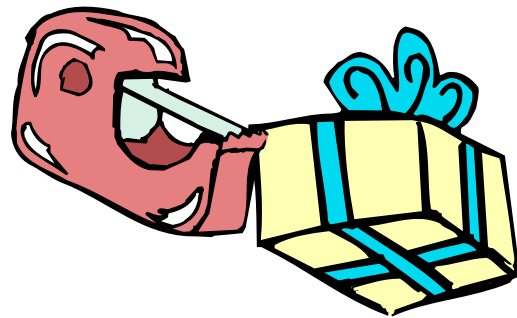
We expect to change again in JUNE or JULY 2006. Mark your calendar for this important opportunity to display your artwork.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists. Limit of three entries per artist. The works presented must have been done in the past three years and not shown in a previous FAA show.

All work must be original by the artist.
NO WORKSHOP OR CLASS WORK

ENTRY FEE (non-refundable):

FAA members: Each entry \$15.00, 3 / \$40.00

Non-members: Each entry \$20.00

Non-members may apply for membership.

CASH AWARDS: (APPROX.\$1900.00 TOTAL)

Best of Show: \$200.

Dorothy Finley Best Use of Color Award: \$100.

Popular Choice Award: \$100.

Plein Air Award: \$100.

In each category: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25

In categories with few entries the number of awards may be limited.

SPECIFICATIONS:

All work must be dry, framed securely, with screweyes and wire attached, ready to hang. No sawtooth hangers. Artist name, phone number, titles on back of each. Total length on any one side including frame shall not exceed 54 inches. Diptychs or triptychs considered as one work. Three-dimensional works weighing more than 50 pounds, the artist is responsible for placement in the show and for removal. No size limit on three-dimensional stand alone works, but must be of reasonable size, Show Chairs will determine. Paintings, photos, graphics, computer works and mixed media may be covered with glass if the size is 24"x24" or less excluding frame. Plexiglas is required on larger pieces, pastels and charcoal works exempted. Gallery wraps, ends finished.

ALL WORK ENTERED MUST BE SUITABLE FOR GENERAL VIEWING.

COMMISSIONS

A 20% commission on ALL sales resulting from this show shall be made to the Fallbrook Art Association.
