Fee is \$5 per piece of artwork, limited to 2 pieces per artist. Paintings must be dry, framed adequately and ready to hang with wire attached.

No sawtooth hangers. VERY IMPORTANT: Artist's name, phone number and title of the art is required on the back of each piece. 10% commission is payable by the artist to the Bob Burton Center for the Performing Arts for any artwork sold during the showing. The artist, not the Fallbrook Art Association, is responsible for any sales tax on items involved in the transaction.

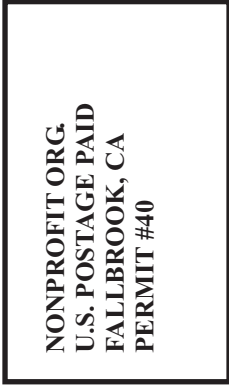
