

Color Demonstration

B. J. Wilson, our guest demonstrator, has been in the Art Business for a long time. First at Bullocks Westwood in the Display Dept.. She worked in between classes, sometimes doing their newspaper ads. Advertising agencies in downtown Los Angeles were next. She freelanced as retouoching and hand lettering. a graphic designer, but it was a feast or famine situation. There was no time to play tennis if times were good and jobs were coming in. She coached students at Woodbury College the semester before they graduated and then became an Art Director for a small agency in Hollywood,

where she did it all, except airbrush

"I found the best of the best for me," she says, When I discovered that teaching enthusiastic adults was such a pleasure." When she lectured at SM College for a number of years, her classes were always larger at the end of the semester than they were at the beginning. Later she moved East and taught painting at the Americal

University in Washington, D.C. where the painting style was quite different than in Demo/Workshop Schedule California. "We have sunshine and a distant horizon. They had mountains in your face." Today, in addition to painting, she lectures, teaches one class per week, Pastels judges shows (San Bernardino County Fair in May, 2010) and takes good painters to Western Europe to paint for three weeks, sometimes offering University credit. For example, three weeks of painting, museum trips and unforgetable experiences for three credits. "Everybody works hard and it's great!"

Directions for the small drawings you will use:

Make 5 drawings on substantial paper (6X6 with at least an inch border on all 4 sides). If they are larger, they will take too long to do.

Do one and trace off the rest. No scenes. Think of something with without odor (no exceptions). interesting overlapping shapes. (e.g. group of fruits, vegetables closely cropped, plant forms, abstract shapes, etc.) Some small shapes will give you room to maneuver.

All your colors, palette, brushes, water holder, pencil, ballpoint pen. Lunch or nibbles.
