ELIGIBILITY: FAA membership is not required. All works must be dry and suitable for general viewing. Works entered must not have been shown in a previous FAA show. All work must be original. Limit of 2 entries per artist. **All entrants must register to sit the Gallery for 3 hrs. If an entrant is unable to gallery sit, he / she must pay a fee of \$25 for a sitter provided by FAC.**

SPECIFICATIONS: Artist's name, phone number, title of work and asking price must be legibly printed on back of each entry. **NO** saw-tooth hangers. All work must have screw eyes and wire (ends taped) strong enough for weight of piece. Maximum framed width, including diptychs and triptychs, is 50". No height limit. 3-dimensional piece maximum weight is 50 lbs. Paintings, photos, graphics, computer works and mixed media **may be covered with glass if the size is 30"x30" or less** (excluding frame). **Plexiglas is required on larger pieces** – except on pastels and charcoal works. No work may be removed from the gallery until the close of the show

WHEN: Saturday, October 11th , 10-12:00

TIME: 10 AM– 12 PM Drop-off/pick-up of art.

WHERE: Fallbrook High School, 2400 Stagecoach Lane at South Mission. Go to the Bob Burton theater, which is located east of the administration buildings beside the baseball field.

NOTE: Do not park in the red NO STOPPING OR PARKING FIRE LANE ZONES directly in front of the theater. You may be ticketed

This is not a juried event but we cannot accept more than 42 pieces due to space limitations. Works will be accepted on a first-come-first-served basis. This opportunity is open to FAA members only. There is no theme, but works depicting the performing arts are particularly welcome.

Artists are limited to two pieces per entrant. A \$5 fee for each piece submitted (cash or check made out to the Fallbrook Art Assn.) is due upon submission. All works will hang for six months and may not be removed before the next change-out. All works must be suitable for general viewing. Any work deemed not suitable will not be accepted. All media is accepted with the exception of 3-D. Paintings must be dry, properly framed, and ready to hang with wire attached, no saw-tooth hangers. Artist's name, phone number, email, title of work, medium and price (if for sale) must be affixed to the back of each submittal.

SALES: All inquiries regarding sales will be handled through Exhibit Chair, Bev DeVilbiss, 760-723-6123. The artist is responsible for all sales transactions including sales tax.
