Photos should reflect "Life in Fallbrook" as a subject.

Specifications: The artists's/photographer's name, phone number, city of residence and title of work must be securely affixed to the back of each original art entry and on an index card paper clipped to photo entries. No entries may be removed from the gallery until the close of show. Original art must be offered for sale. Photo entries will not be offered for sale.
